- The author is responsible for the information and facts presented in the article.
- The criteria for the selection of articles are their compliance with the profile of the journal, novelty, relevance, and validity of the results. Submitted manuscripts will not be returned.
- Works published and/or accepted for publication in other publications cannot be sent to the editorial office. By sending the article to the editor, the author agrees to edit the material.
- All materials received by the editors are checked for originality through open sources, the check is carried out using the Anti-plagiarism system.
- Articles sent to the editor are registered. The date listed is the date a complete set of materials is submitted. If the article is returned to the author for revision, the date of registration is the date of receipt of the final text.
- The file sent to the editor through the article acceptance platform must be named with the author's last name (for example, O.Abdullaev.doc)
- The editors reserve the right to linguistically edit the article.
- Materials not accepted for publication will not be returned to the authors.
